

Alternative Facilities

For Change of use of former Job centre, two storey rear extension and create 3 flats at 11 Perrot Street, Treharris CF46 5ER.

The job centre at 11 Perrot Street closed in the mid 1990's. There are alternative Job Centres at Pontypridd, Merthyr Tydfil and Aberdare.

The closure of smaller job centres was part of the rebranding of Job Centres to Job Centre plus also Between 2012 and 2018 a government website named Universal Job match was used whereby jobseekers could search for employment and employers could upload and manage their own vacancies whilst searching for prospective employees, This became the UK's most visited recruitment website with over a million visitors each week.

When the Building ceased to be a Job Centre there were no other agencies who would use or take over the building as a Job Centre.

By changing the use of an empty building which has been boarded up for many years it would not result in the creation of a dead frontage within the street, but would match the residential properties either side.

The picture below shows the condition of the property, and the property to the left is owned by the applicant of this planning application and show the standard the property will be brought back too.
